HOW DOES JESUS RESTORE US?

1. JESUS TURNS MY HURTS INTO

"We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28 (NIV)

"For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son, so that his Son would be the First, with many brothers." Romans 8:29 (LB)

2. JESUS TAKES MY SINS ON _____ (AT THE CROSS)

"But because of our sins he was wounded, beaten because of the evil we did. We are healed by the punishment he suffered, made whole by the blows he received. All of us were like sheep that were lost, each of us going his own way. But the Lord made the punishment fall on him, the punishment all of us deserved. He was treated harshly, but endured it humbly; he never said a word. Like a lamb about to be slaughtered, like a sheep about to be sheared, he never said a word." Isaiah 53:5-7 (GNT)

3. JESUS _____ MY GRIEF AND _____ MY HEART

"We despised him and rejected him; he endured suffering and pain. No one would even look at him—we ignored him as if he were nothing. "But he endured the suffering that should have been ours, the pain that we should have borne. All the while we thought that his suffering was punishment sent by God." Isaiah 53:3-4 (GNT)

2. RELEASE MY OFFENDERS & _____ ON THE FUTURE

"Stop being mean, bad-tempered, and angry. Quarreling, harsh words, and dislike of others should have no place in your lives. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God has forgiven you because you belong to Christ." Ephesians 4:31–32 (LB)

"Never avenge yourselves. <u>Leave that to God</u>, for He has said He will repay those who deserve it." **Romans 12:19 (LB)**

3. TEAM UP WITH JESUS TO CARRY MY ____

"When you go through deep waters and great trouble, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown! When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up—the flames will not consume you." Isaiah 43:2 (LB)
