MEMORY VERSE: Fearing people is a dangerous trap, but trusting the Lord means safety. **Proverbs 29:25 (NLT)**

1. WHAT THE FEAR OF REJECTION DOES TO US

- Allows others to manipulate us
- Causes us to conform to peer pressure
- Keeps us from speaking the truth
- Prevents us from giving and receiving love
- Causes shyness and loneliness
- Produces depression and unhappiness
- Silences our sharing about Christ

"I have sinned, Saul finally admitted. Yes, I have disobeyed your instructions and the command of the Lord, for I was afraid of the people and did what they demanded." 1 Samuel 15:24 (LB)
