EIGHT OPTIONS FOR LEAVING A LEGACY

Areas to Consider:

- ___ **Volunteer:** Donate substantial time & energy to a kingdom cause or ministry.
- ___ **Donor:** Contribute financial resources to a kingdom cause or ministry.
- ___ **Business as Ministry:** Use your business to accomplish kingdom work.
- ___ **Partner:** Team up as a silent partner with someone involved full-time in a kingdom cause and supply that individual in whatever ways produce results.
- ___ **Board Member:** Provide expertise and support to a non-profit organization committed to a kingdom cause.
- ___ **Parallel Career:** Take on major responsibility in a kingdom cause, even as you continue to carry out your vocational commitments.
- ___ **Career Change:** Serve full-time in a kingdom cause or ministry.
- ___ **Social Entrepreneur:** Start and build a new non-profit organization to fulfill a kingdom cause or unmet need in an innovative way.
