HOW TO DEFEAT THE GIANTS IN MY LIFE 4 Lessons from the Story of David & Goliath

"Then Goliath, a Philistine champion from Gath, came out of the Philistine ranks to face the forces of Israel. He was a giant of a man, measuring over nine feet tall! He wore a bronze helmet, a two-hundred-pound coat of mail, bronze leggings, and carried a bronze javelin several inches thick, tipped with a twenty-five-pound iron spearhead, and his armor bearer walked ahead of him with a huge shield. He stood and shouted across to the Israelis, Do you need a whole army to settle this? I will represent the Philistines, and you choose someone to represent you, and we will settle this in single combat! If your man is able to kill me, then we will be your slaves. But if I kill him, then you must be our slaves! I defy the armies of Israel! Send me a man who will fight with me! When Saul and the Israeli army heard this, they were dismayed and frightened." 1 Samuel 17:4-11 (LB)

1. I CALL MY GIANT BY IT'S _____ NAME.

David asked the men standing near him, "What will be done for the man who kills this Philistine and removes this disgrace from Israel? Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?" **1 Samuel 17:26 (NIV)**

2. I REFLECT ON WHAT GOD HAS _____ IN THE PAST.

"Don't worry about this Philistine, David told Saul. I'll go fight him! Don't be ridiculous! Saul replied. There's no way you can fight this Philistine and possibly win! You're only a boy, and he's been a man of war since his youth. But David persisted. I have been taking care of my father's sheep and goats, he said. When a lion or a bear comes to steal a lamb from the flock, I go after it with a club and rescue the lamb from its mouth. If the animal turns on me, I catch it by the jaw and club it to death. I have done this to both lions and bears, and I'll do it to this pagan Philistine, too, for he has defied the armies of the living God! The Lord who rescued me from the claws of the lion and the bear will rescue me from this Philistine! Saul finally consented. All right, go ahead, he said. And may the Lord be with you!"

1 Samuel 17:32-37 (NLT)

- **I REMEMBER THE FIGHT IS NOT _____, IT'S THE LORD'S.**

"And everyone assembled here will know that the Lord rescues his people, but not with sword and spear. This is the Lord's battle, and he will give you to us!" **1 Samuel 17:47 (NLT)**

3. I MOVE _____ WITH GOD IN SPITE OF MY FEAR.

David answered, "You are coming against me with sword, spear, and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the Israelite armies, which you have defied. This very day the Lord will put you in my power; I will defeat you and cut off your head. And I will give the bodies of the Philistine soldiers to the birds and animals to eat. Then the whole world will know that Israel has a God, and everyone here will see that the Lord does not need swords or spears to save his people. He is victorious in battle, and he will put all of you in our power. Goliath started walking towards David again, and David ran quickly towards the Philistine battle line to fight him."

1 Samuel 17:45-48 (GNB)

"Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." **Matthew 28:20 (NLT)**

4. I TRUST GOD TO GIVE ME THE _____.

"He put his hand into his bag and took out a stone, which he slung at Goliath. It hit him on the forehead and broke his skull, and Goliath fell face downwards on the ground. And so, without a sword, David defeated and killed Goliath with a sling and a stone! He ran to him, stood over him, took Goliath's sword out of its sheath, and cut off his head and killed him. When the Philistines saw that their hero was dead, they ran away. The men of Israel and Judah shouted and ran after them, pursuing them all the way to Gath and to the gates of Ekron. The Philistines fell wounded all along the road that leads to Shaaraim, as far as Gath and Ekron." **1 Samuel 17:49-52 (GNB)**
