## HOW TO LIVE FOR GOD TO SAY WELL DONE

### 1. LIVE EVERY DAY WITH \_\_\_\_\_.

*"It is written: As surely as I live, says the Lord, every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God. So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God."*

**Romans 14:11–12 (NIV)**

**How:** \_\_\_\_\_ **that every decision is seen by God. Start and end your day with accountability in mind.**

**Practice:** Ask yourself daily: *"If I had to return the loan today, would I be ready?"*

### 2. BE FAITHFUL IN THE \_\_\_\_\_ THINGS.

*"It is required... that they be found faithful."*

**1 Corinthians 4:2 (ESV)**

**How:** Don't \_\_\_\_\_ for a big assignment—be faithful where you are. Faithfulness in small things opens the door to bigger responsibilities.

**Practice:** Identify one "small" area (finances, prayer, service, family) and recommit to being faithful this week.

### 3. LIVE WITH THE \_\_\_\_\_ IN MIND.

*"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing."* **2 Timothy 4:7–8 (NIV)**

**Matthew 25:21 (NIV)**

**How:** Keep your eyes on the \_\_\_\_\_ line. Remember, joy comes when you return the loan not just intact, but multiplied.

**Practice:** Write down \_\_\_\_\_ where you want to hear God's "well done," and begin living it out daily.

## SUMMARY APPLICATIONS

2. Practice faithfulness in hidden places, not just visible ones.
3. Reinvest your time, talent, and treasure into things with eternal value.
