**I. PRESENT YOUR _____ TO GOD
 (Surrender Control)**

*"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies
 of God, that you present your bodies a living
 sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your
 reasonable service."* **Romans 12:1 (NKJV)**

“Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.” **Luke 22:42 (NIV)**

Control is the _____ of closeness.

Action Steps:

- Identify **one area you resist surrendering to God**

- Pray daily: **“Lord, I trust You with this.”**
- Fast this week from **complaining or trying to control outcomes**

II. PURIFY YOUR _____ BEFORE GOD (Repent Deeply)

“...that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God.” **Romans 12:1 (NKJV)**

“Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.” **Psalm 51:1-4 (ESV)**

“Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.” **Psalm 51:10 (ESV)**

Action Steps:

- Confess sin **privately and specifically to God**
- Make **restitution where necessary**
- Seek **accountability if a struggle continues**

III. PLACE _____ AT GOD’S DISPOSAL (Remain Available)

Romans 12:1 ends with this phrase: “This is your reasonable service.”

Action Steps:

- Pray each morning: **“Lord, use me today.”**
- Serve **someone sacrificially this week**
- Say **yes to a prompting from the Holy Spirit**
